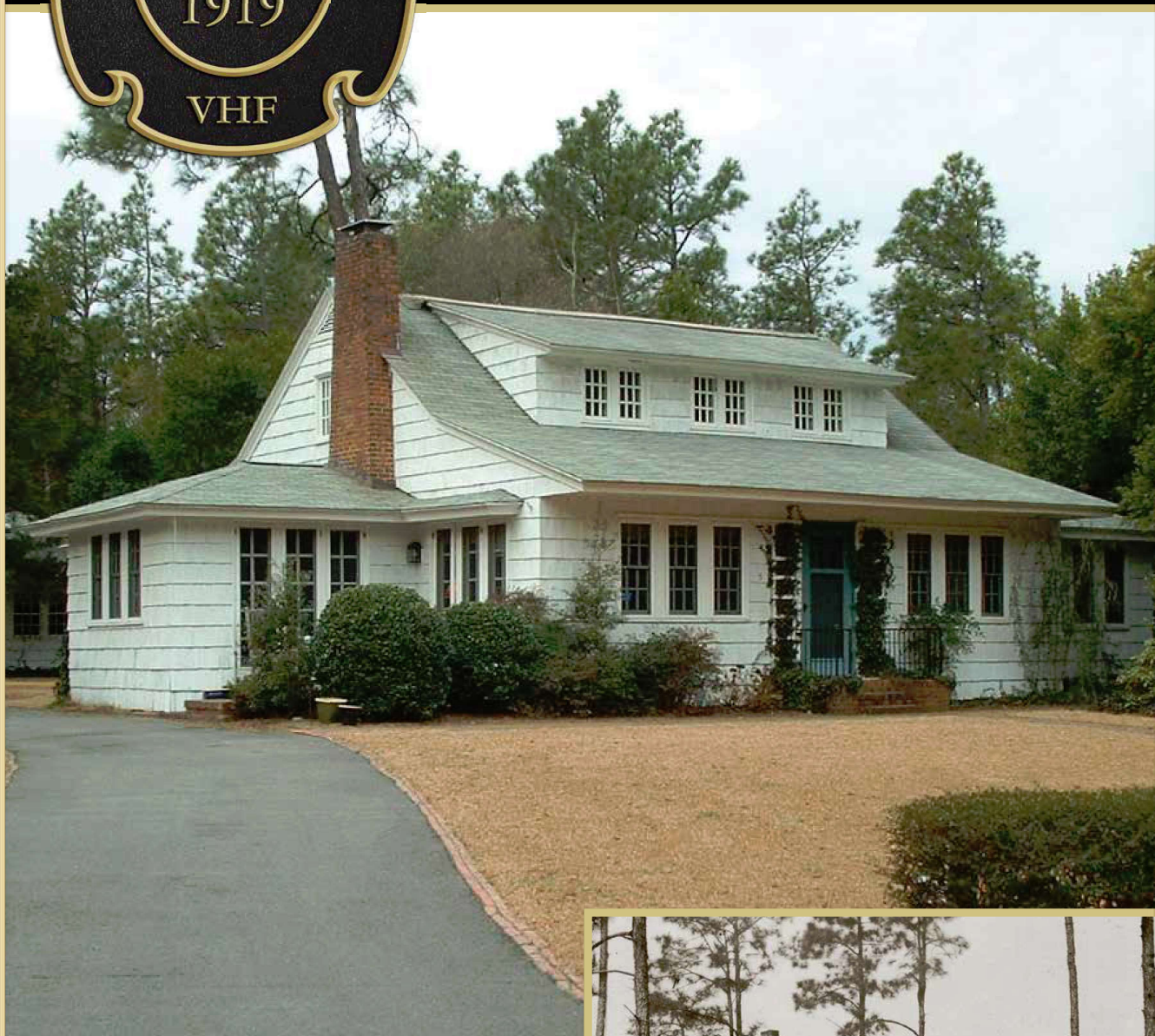




HALFWAY HOUSE
EST. 1919
15 CAROLINA VISTA

John Warren Watson built 'Halfway House' for his mother Mrs. T. T. Watson in 1919. It is a one and a half story bungalow with double pitched gable roof and long shed dormers across the front and rear.



A picket gate with a privet hedge is located at the front of the house and has been there for almost one hundred years. It is called 'Halfway House' because it is exactly halfway between The Carolina Hotel and the Pinehurst Country Club. Mr. Watson's own house was by a large lake at the Country Club of North Carolina so he named the guest cottage on the adjacent property 'Dry Dock'.
